# Incidental Welsh Language

GASC continues to use incidental Welsh e.g. bore da (good morning), diolch (thank you), rhifau (numbers) 1 to 20, lliwiau (colours), coch (red), glas (blue), du (black), melyn (yellow), etc.

Some bi-lingual posters are on display and a book or game, which will be either bi-lingual or in the Welsh language, will be out each session.

When GASC had its last inspection the use of the Welsh language was highlighted as needing to be improved, so all the staff are trying to increase the amount of the Welsh language being used.

## Numbers

Some sessions at GASC are full especially Tuesday afternoons. GASC is registered for no more than 32 children at each session. The ratio of one member of staff to eight children for the under 8s and 1:10 for 8 and over. These ratios are set in law by the Welsh Government and are enforced by the CIW (Care Inspectorate Wales).

Bookings are allocated on a first come first served basis and GASC would be grateful if you would book and pay half termly in advance, which would reduce the amount od administration considerably, however, GASC will always try to be flexible. If you just turn up at the gate GASC cannot guarantee a place.

## Sheds

GASC was successful in applying for grant to supply two sheds, one is a shelter to provide a place for children to play when the weather is inclement, complete with benches. The other to store outside play loose parts.
